## TOTAL SUPPORT

**£27,387,558**

overall support provided

- **373** grants awarded to local and national charities totalling **£6,637,013**
- **2,883** individuals helped through grants totalling **£14,330,545**
- **£6,420,000** in support provided for residential care



## LOCAL COMMUNITY SUPPORT

**£104,539** given to charities in Cambridgeshire

- **£15,000** for children aged up to five affected by poverty and neglect
- **£15,000** for children affected by domestic abuse
- **£60,000** for children with special educational needs and disabilities
- **£4,539** given through Hospice UK grants in your Province
- **£10,000** for other charitable causes
