Our project supported children and young people aged between 3-18 years old in the Flintshire area that had experienced domestic abuse. We provided 1-2-1 support to help reduce the levels of distress children often feel when entering refuge or following experiences of domestic abuse. Children were assisted to develop trust in others and an understanding they are not to blame; along with positive coping mechanisms to recover from abuse.”
